RIDE CATEGORIES:

AA - Flat, easy pace, open invitation ride typically 18 to 20 miles to coffee.

A - Easy(ish) possibly a few gentle climbs; some experience necessary, typically 20 to 25 miles to coffee.

B - Hills, experience and stamina necessary; maybe some light off-road stuff, up to to 30 miles to coffee.

C - Long ride requiring very good stamina and food supplies. Check with Captain for details.

In addition to the Club Rides listed there will be a Fast Sports Ride (which may not stop for coffee) - this is not a training ride.
