IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY:

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets.

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

Be warned you now have to Sign in before you Start, and again Sign out after you have raced, when you hand back your number, or your time will be disqualified.

The Course:-U72

Course description: U72

Start at bus stop lay-by just before the speed de-restriction sign leaving Maisemore (grid reference 811212). Continue to Staunton, turning left at the roundabout (Care here). Continue on the A417 across the M50 junction and on to the first roundabout on the edge of Ledbury. Turn here (13.5 miles). Retrace the route, turning right at the roundabout in Staunton (Care here). Finish beyond the old school buildings beyond Hartpury at the pull-in by a gate into the woods (grid reference 798234).

1. Start, out of H.Q turn right and right onto A417 start on left 200m – give 5 minutes.
2. Shout number as you pass timekeeper at finish
3. Avoid U turns in vicinity of start and finish
4. CTT strongly advise hard shell helmets and Rear **flashing lights**
5. After the Finish please hand in number & sign out to obtain drinks & refreshments.
6. Please stay after if you can, for the small presentation of prizes & refreshments.

***** PLEASE BE AWARE OF LARGE POT HOLES ABOUT 1/2 MILE FROM M50 JUNCTION ON THE WAY BACK. ALSO GENERAL ONES ALONG THE WAY, WHICH WE COME TO EXPECT NOW.**

H Q: - Maisemore Village Hall, Church Road (off A417) Maisemore, Gloucester. GL2 8JE

Maisemore Village Hall is about 1 ½ miles north –west outside Gloucester. This will be open from about 8.30. Please do **NOT** wear cleats into the polished wood floor of the Hall.

Signing-on/off and numbers will be available at the HQ.

Please call out your number for the timekeeper at the finish. Failure to do so could result in no time being accredited.

Safety:-

Please obey the rules of the road.

Keep your head up!

No u-turns in the vicinity of the start and finish. This is an ‘A’ road and should be treated with caution.

The TG Hall Handicap Cup will be awarded to the Fastest Gloucester City Rider on Handicap.
