TREASURERS REPORT FOR 1984

Mr President Ladies & gentlemen

For the second year in succession I am able to report that the clubs finances are in a healthy state. The number of subscriptions paid has dropped from 48 to 42 a reduction of 6. However most of this loss has been caused by members claiming Honorary Membership on completion of 15 years with the club so the membership is more or less static. This is disappointing after a rise of 12 in 1983. I am sure you would wish me to thank all the members who made donations towards the cost of the News Letters and Runs Lists during the year.

The clubroom has again more than payed its way with the numbers of attendances reaching 708 a rise of 61 on 1983 and the best since 1978. Some concern was felt in April when the line charge was raised to £4 per evening. This has not turned out to be the case and providing members pay their subs each evening it will not be necessary to increase the entrance fees next year. I hope that volunteers can be found to make the coffee at least during the winter evenings. Lets put some money back into the club instead of the bar and the fruit machines.

We were very surprised this year when it became necessary to ^{revalue} the club trophies ~~revalued~~ to find that their value had more than trebled since 1980. Some expenditure will have to be made this year on several of the trophies as no further space exists for future holders to be recorded.

In conclusion I would like to thank all thoughs members who have had the courage to come forward and devote there time to organising the clubs events. All the members who pay their subs without being chased for several months and all thoughs who offer clubroom subs before retiring to the bar for the rest of the evening.

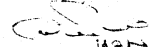

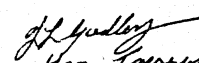
