RIDE CATEGORIES:

The **Moderate** rides listed here are split into three categories: A, B, and C; there are also **Tempo** and **Intermediate** rides, which are faster and may go to different destinations: these are determined the week prior to the Sunday. **Fast** rides are also organised the week prior to the Sunday, depending on weather and availability and may have a coffee stop at the end, in or around Gloucester.

Moderate ride categories:

A: Reasonably flat, easy pace, open invitation ride; typically 18 to 24 miles to coffee.

B: Expect some hills: experience and stamina necessary; typically 24 to 30 miles to coffee.

C: Long ride requiring very good stamina and food supplies. Check with Captain for details.
