RISE CATEGORIES:

There is one Introductory Ride on this listing, on the 13th September. Gentle pace with minimal hills; around 15 miles to coffee at the Maisemore race HQ.

The **Moderate** rides listed here are split into three categories: A, B, and C; there are also **Tempo** and **Intermediate** rides, which are faster and may go to different destinations: these are determined during the week prior to the Sunday. **Fast** rides are also organised the week prior to the Sunday, depending on weather and availability and may have a coffee stop at the end, in or around Gloucester.

Moderate ride categories:
A: Reasonably flat, easy pace; typically 18 to 24 miles to coffee.
B: Expect some hills: experience and stamina necessary; typically 24 to 32 miles to coffee.
C: Long ride requiring very good stamina and food supplies. Check with Captain for details.

NOTE: Open event: Autumn Hardriders 25 TT, Sunday 13th September, Maisemore with social to follow. Helpers required please!

NOTE: Autumn Tour: Weekend 25th to 27th September to Abingdon, Oxfordshire: ride there on Friday; circular ride Saturday; return home on Sunday.

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
